# 16 local groups get \$1.2M in Lutheran Foundation grants

Sixteen area not-for-profit organizations and Lutheran churches have received more than \$1.2 million in Partnership Program Grants from the Lutheran Foundation of St. Louis since the beginning of 2007, the foundation said Thursday.

The foundation, awards grants in the areas of health, human care, Lutheran congregations' community service programs, and Lutheran education. It has \$4.4 million available for new grant awards in 2007.
